



# Honduras renewable electricity

Is Honduras a renewable country?

Honduras is also one of the first non-island countries that has been able to use 10% of its solar energy for electric generation. Other forms of renewable energy include biomass at 10%, wind at 7% and geothermal at 1%. Honduras has switched to renewable energy as a means of being self-sufficient.

Can Honduras build energy self-sufficiency?

Regardless of the challenges that still face Honduras, that country has been able to make a good deal of progress in building energy self-sufficiency since the reform implementations. Efforts to establish renewable energy in Honduras are improving people's quality of life and stimulating the economy.

Do Hondurans have access to electricity?

Hondurans still do not have universal access to electricity. Only 87% of the population had access to electricity in 2016, which largely comprised of Hondurans living in urban cities. For citizens to feel the full benefits of renewable energy in Honduras, everyone must have access to electricity.

What does the Secretariat of energy do in Honduras?

The Secretariat of Energy (SEN) is the primary government body responsible for overseeing the energy sector in Honduras, including mini-grid development. It sets national energy policies, plans rural electrification strategies, and coordinates with stakeholders to implement mini-grid projects.
