



How to check the base station battery

Getting the battery in can feel a little tricky at first, but no worries, once you know the move, it's smooth sailing. One important thing to know up front: the Base Station and GameHub do not use a click-in ...

The installation area of the base station should be at least 200m away from any high-power radio sources (such as TV stations, microwave stations, etc.), and at least 50m away from ...
