



# How to pay taxes on photovoltaic panel brackets

Do you pay taxes on solar panels?

Most homeowners with a decent tax bill will fall into this category, using up the credit in the installation year and enjoying a much lower tax payment. In essence, the government just covered \$7,500 of their solar costs through the tax system.

Can I claim a tax credit if I install a solar PV system?

Yes, but if the residence where you install a solar PV system serves multiple purposes (e.g., you have a home office or your business is located in the same building), claiming the tax credit can be more complicated.

Do solar panels qualify for a federal tax credit?

The answer depends heavily on your specific circumstances. The IRS states in Questions 25 and 26 in its Q&A on Tax Credits<sup>13</sup> that off-site solar panels or solar panels that are not directly on the taxpayer's home could still qualify for the residential federal solar tax credit under some circumstances.

Are solar panels tax deductible?

However, if less than 80% of the solar PV system cost is a residential expense, only the percentage that is residential spending can be used to calculate the federal solar tax credit for the individual's tax return; the portion that is a business expense could be eligible for a similar commercial ITC on the business's tax return.<sup>12</sup>
