Los Angeles Metro - Monrovia Station is a Electric Station situated at 1651 S Primrose Ave Located on the ground floor of the parking garage Monrovia, California CA, US.

Monrovia station is an at-grade light rail station on the A Line of the Los Angeles Metro Rail system. It is located at the intersection of Duarte Road and Myrtle Avenue in Monrovia, California, after which the station is named.

Multifamily residential project planned next to Gold Line stop. Richman Group plans 296 apartments just off of the Gold Line.

The Monrovia Station is part of the Foothill Gold Line from Pasadena to Azusa, completed on time and on budget on September 23, 2015. The 11.5-mile, six-station extension was then turned over to Metro.
