



# San diego solar storage cabine grid-connected procurement contract

This Resolution approves the contracts for San Diego Gas & Electric Company's four utility-owned circuit-level energy storage microgrid projects for a total of 39 megawatts of incremental capacity.

The order aims at ensuring the reliability of California's grid toward the middle of the decade, and marked the agency's largest-ever capacity procurement in one shot.
