

What are the regulations enacted by the Spanish government?

3.2.3 Since December 2012, the Spanish Government has enacted several regulations, aimed at the reduction of the tariff deficit and the economic balance of the electricity sector. These include:

Will Spain strengthen its electricity system after a power outage?

The Spanish government has approved legislation to strengthen its electricity system following the major power outage the country experienced in April.

Who enforces the voltage control regulations in Spain?

Spanish independent competition regulator, the National Markets and Competition Commission (CNMC), will enforce the regulations. The watchdog will have to compile a monitoring report on compliance with the voltage control obligations of all operators who are obliged to do so. The report must be presented within six months.

How much electricity does Spain generate?

2.1.5 According to the latest available data from REE, electricity generated under the special regime accounted for almost 38% of total electricity generation in the Spanish peninsula in 2012, corresponding to 102,152 GW<sup>4</sup>, meaning that the country has already exceeded the European Union goal of 20% of energy coming from renewable generation <sup>5</sup>.
